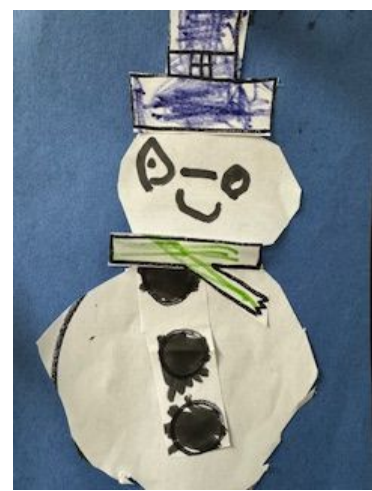

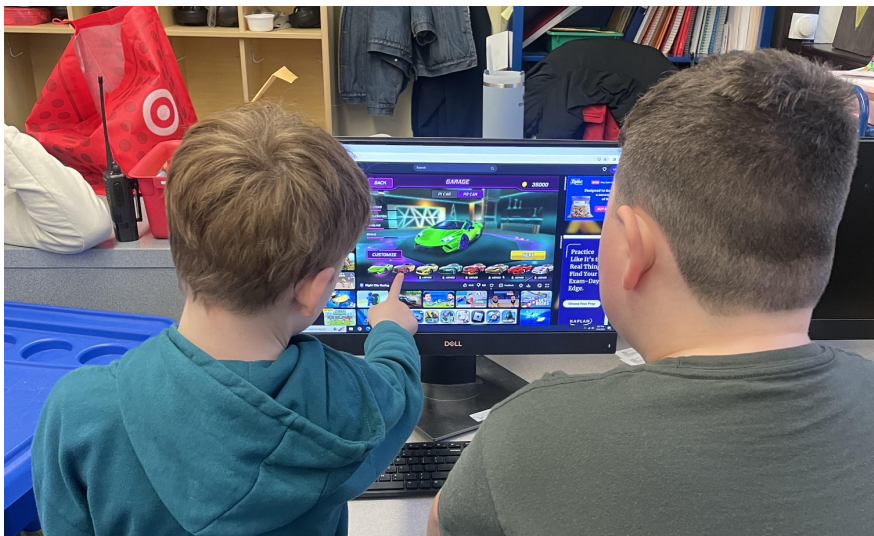


Making Snowmen with our Occupational Therapists
